## **Brief Overview of the Program**

The Emerging Leaders Cohort program was developed to provide HQ level education and discipleship for key emerging leaders of UBF chapters in North America and around the world. It provides a platform where key leaders meet with senior staff/leaders to build up relationships, learn and grow in God's word, and embrace God's vision for the future of UBF. ELC is a supportive and enhancing program for the UBF chapters' disciple-raising ministries.

Target group: Emerging ministry key leaders who are:

- 1. disciples with a solid Bible study history and have desire to serve Christ's mission, especially campus ministry
- 2. recommended by their chapter leader

The course requires about 2 hours of work per week and follows the school year (Sep - May). There are 2 courses of 8 lessons each (noted below). The 8 sessions are about 5 weeks apart. Each session requires an all day Saturday for the

meeting (usually in Chicago or sometimes in other chapters or when necessary online attendance). Sessions are facilitated by UBF staff in North America (20).

Here is an outline of the 16 sessions:

**Year 1**: God and His Reign; Ministerial Person/Calling; Grace, Sonship and Faith; Worship; Word of God; Walking by the Spirit; Evangelism; Preaching

**Year 2**: Community of Christ; Marriage and Family; Counseling; Spiritual Warfare; Worldviews/Apologetics; Leadership; N.A. Campus Ministry; UBF Mission, Vision & Strategy
