1. Review what Jesus had done for the man born blind (3-7). What was the man's account the first time he was questioned? (8-12) Who questioned him next? (13) What factual account did he give? (13-15)

- 2. Why did the Pharisees dispute about Jesus? (14-16) When they asked him for his opinion about Jesus, what did he say? (17) What did this mean?
- 3. Why did the Pharisees not believe the man's story? Why did they ask his parents about him? (18) What did his parents say? (19-21) Why did they refuse to identify Jesus as the healer? (22-23)
- 4. Read verse 24. When the Pharisees summoned the man a second time, what did they want him to say about Jesus? Why?
- 5. Read verse 25. What did he say? What might it cost him to make this testimony? Read verses 26-27. When they kept on asking the same question, how did he answer? What decision and commitment do his words reveal?
- 6. Read verses 28-29. Why did the Pharisees become angry and hurl insults at this man? Read verses 30-33. How had this man born blind progressed in his faith and commitment? What did he teach the Pharisees? Read verse 34. What did they say and do?
- 7. Read verses 35-38. How did Jesus help this man receive spiritual sight? What did the man realize about Jesus? Why did he worship him? What can we learn from this man about how spiritual blindness can be healed?
- 8. Read verses 39-41. What did Jesus say about the meaning of his coming into the world? In what way were the Pharisees blind? What did Jesus teach them?
