- 3. Read verses 44-46. What does the parable of the hidden treasure teach about the kingdom of heaven? The parable of the pearl of great value? How can we have a Christian value system?
- 4. Read verses 47-52. How is the net let down into the lake like the kingdom? What does this parable teach about the end of the age? Why did Jesus want to make sure that his disciples understood?
- 5. Read verses 36-43. Why did Jesus explain the parable of the weeds? Why is it necessary to know that there is a day of judgment, heaven and hell?
