STUDY QUESTIONS

- 1. Read 13:53-58. Where did Jesus go first when he came home? Why? When Jesus taught the Bible to his hometown people what was the first response? Why?
- 2. Why did they take offense at him? How did Jesus view this? Why did their lack of faith hinder his work?
- 3. Read 14:1-12. When King Herod heard about the work of Jesus, what was his reaction? Why? What kind of man was Herod? In what sense was he a slave?
- 4. Why did Herod not want to kill John? How and why did he do so? What can we learn here about the fruits of an immoral life?
- 5. Who was John the Baptist? What was his mission? (Jn 1:29; Isa 40:3-5) How did John show himself to be faithful to his mission? What reveals John's true freedom? What did it cost for him to fulfill his mission? What did he gain?
