JESUS IS THE GOOD SHEPHERD

John 10:1-21 Key Verse: 11

- 1. What did Jesus say to the Pharisees and why (1, and previous passage)? How is the shepherd characterized in contrast to the thief/robber/stranger, and how does this describe Jesus (2-5)? What do his sheep know? Why didn't the Pharisees understand Jesus (6)?
- 2. What does Jesus mean by "I am the gate for the sheep" (7)? What promises does Jesus make as the gate, and how does this contrast the thief (8-10, and verse 9 footnote)? What do you think to have "life to the full" means?
- 3. How does the good shepherd differ from the hired hand (11-13)? What is the greatest love that our good shepherd Jesus showed his sheep (15:13; 1Jn 3:16)? What is our good shepherd Jesus' relationship to his sheep (14-15)?
- 4. Who are the other sheep and what responsibility does Jesus take towards them (16; 17:20-21)? How and why did Jesus lay down his life and take it up again (17-18)? How were responses to Jesus' words divided (19-21)?
- 5. Do you have the assurance that Jesus is the good shepherd for you personally and for all people (Ps 23:1)? How can you be a good sheep to Jesus?
