RESTORING OUR FIRST LOVE

Revelation 2:4-5a, "Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first."

- 1. Review Jesus' commendation for the church at Ephesus (2:1-3,6). Yet what did Jesus rebuke them for (4)? What did he tell them to do and what was his warning if they did not (5)?
- 2. Why is loving Jesus so important as a first priority (Dt 6:5; Mt 22:35-38)? Why is this so difficult for anyone (1Jn 2:15-17; Mt 6:24)?
- 3. Consider: what are the things that you and your church "did at first" out of love for Jesus? How can we "repent and do the things [we] did at first"? What is the danger of doing "deeds" for Jesus without a right heart (2,4)?
- 4. How can we practically love Jesus personally (5a; Jn 14:15,21)? How can we love Jesus as a church (Heb 10:24-25; Col 3:16-17; Ac 2:42)?
